How we work

To achieve our aims, members work together to:

- ▼ build a democratic, revolutionary organisation that is active and networked – in trade unions, schools and colleges, community groups and workplaces;
- ▼ support and take part in demonstrations, pickets, lobbies, direct actions, strikes and occupations;
- ▼ join with affiliated groups internationally, to inspire, share knowledge, integrate and link all our struggles against global capitalism;
- ▼ draw on the most up-to-date knowledge in every field.

How we work

- ▼ Organise local and national meetings, campaigns and consultations
- ▼ Use technology to communicate, educate, organise, consult and take decisions
- ▼ Support members' creativity to make films, audio, presentations, drama, poetry and music.
- ▼ Combine members' knowledge to provide a programme of education and training.
- ▼ Develop and share fresh philosophical and political approaches to problems.

Organisation

- ▼ Members join one or more groups (See chart opposite)
- ▼ Members can propose to form a new group, either around a particular subject or based on their local area.
- ▼ Members pay an agreed subscription to fund work and campaigns (minimum of £5 a month waged; £3 unwaged).
- ▼ A Steering Group is elected by the members at an annual conference or on-line symposium.
- ▼ A secretariat makes sure decisions are carried out between meetings/ consultations. It is elected by the Steering Group.
